Brooks Douglass has had diverse careers in business, politics, the military, and film-making. At 27, he was elected the youngest State Senator to serve in Oklahoma. After retiring from the senate, Brooks began to focus on a long-held passion for writing, acting, and creating. He co-authored, acted in, and produced *The Amendment*, a powerful film honoring his parents, Richard and Marilyn Douglass, who were tragically killed in 1979.



Richard B. Douglass pastored his first church when he was 16 years old and continued this passion and purpose until his death at age 43. In his lifetime, he was head pastor at Putnam City Baptist Church in Oklahoma City and before that other churches in Oklahoma and Texas. He was a missionary with his family in Brazil from 1968 to 1972, author of hundreds of faith-based articles and the book *My Way*, *God's Way* (1978), president of the Southern Baptist Convention of Oklahoma, and dedicated to prison ministries throughout Oklahoma. Richard was loving husband to Marilyn and father to Brooks and Leslie Douglass.
